Make the Resurrection Very Personal

- Xp risen; *risen, indd; all!* All, indd! Makes me so happy hear say: All. 7 wks ago on Trnsfg we: frwll to All joyfl wrd, means praise Lord. Thruout whole ssn/Lent, stoppd using wrd All in hymns/litrgy/pryrs, bec Lent: time/solemn reflctn. But Easter: time for joyful celbrtn, bec we know/bel that: Xp risen; *risen, indd; all!* All; praise Lord!
- Praise LJ for rising fr dead! That's why here today: worship risen LJ w/thnks/praise as celebrt his res! And man, got up pretty early do it! It's early, isn't it?! We don't come ch at 6/morn very often. But we do on East, bec vs. 1. It was very early in morn when: J rose fr dead; and MM found tmb empty. So what better time/place to praise risen Lord, than here in ch, in early hrs of res morning.
- All 4 Goss record res acnt, of course. But each Gos gives diff details & has a diff emphss. Mt emphszs pwr/res: violent earthqk; angel rolled stone away; "apprnc like lghtnng" (28:3); Rom guards actly faintd pwr! Mk's acnt: shrt & to pnt. Lk emphszs how long took for evone bel. Going hear fr Lk's Gos in 9:30 service how: women found tmb empty, didn't undrstnd; so told discs, but thght wrds nonsense; then Pt ran tmb, still didn't bel. And later, on road/Emms, J: "How foolish you are & how slow bel all that prophts've spkn" (24:25); and that night when J apprd, thght ghost. So Lk's emphasizes: how long took for evone bel. But Jn's Gos is diff. Jn makes res very persnl; stirs emtns & tchs hrt. Today we see how J's res tchd hrt of MM, persnly & emtnly. And today I want J's res tch your hrt same way: persnly & emtnly. This blessed East sunrise, I invite/encrg you: make res/J very persnl.
- Vs. 1-2. Her hrt just brkn! She'd just witnssd violnt tortr/exctn/Lord she: right there at cross; saw whole grusm thng; probly cldn't sleep at night or get image out mind. And now all wants do: see one last time & give proper burial. But when gets tmb, body's gone; all can think: those cruel ppl who killed him have now robbed his grave! Mary's hrt is just brkn!
- What you going thru in your life right now that brks/hrt? What stresses you out or brings you dwn? I suppose it's pssbl that evthing in your life right now: hunky-dory; riding high, loving life. But smthing I've learned over yrs is this: evone: strggling w/smthing; fighting sm battle; has some prob dealing with, sm hrtach weighing them dwn. Evone! Maybe not at ev moment. But we all have: our strggls & hrtachs; trbls that affect us very persully. So I think we all can relate to MM.
- But think re this: what if Mary had actly found what looking for? What if she went timb & actly found dead bdy/J lying there? That'd be real hrtbrk! That'd mean J: broke prom; nvr rose; is not God and cld not forgive sins, give peace, bring hvn. That'd mean: Gos is hoax, J charlatan, Xianity lie. Remem Paul: "If Xp has not been raised, your faith futile; still in sins" (1 Cor 15:17). If Mary'd actly found J dead in tomb, then she'd really have reason be hrtbrkn. And so would we, bec we wld've belvd in Sav who cldn't save & Rdmr who didn't redeem.
- But: Xp risen; risen indd; all! And that fact isn't just pwrfl; also persnl. When you, like Mary, are feeling hrtbrkn, stressd out, weighd dwn, weary/burdnd, J makes his res very persnl for you. That's what did for Mary. Vs. 11-12 to reassure Mary/us that what'd hapnd: not robbry but res. Vs. 13a (hear that qstn again in just sec); vs. 13b (hear anguish!). But then: vs. 14-15a/crying. And not like J didn't know! But asked (& had angels ask) to help Mary make res very persnl. J'd not left her or let her dwn; J kept wrd & rose fr dead, for her, indvdly, persnly! Why crying? that's a very persnl qstn that tchd her brkn hrt. It took her a sec: "gardnr; where put him; I'll get." But for rest/life, in ev diffclt situation she'd face in life, she'd be able look back on that exchng & say: "Why am I crying? I have no reason: cry or be sad. My J: risen/dead. He loves me, saved, forgvs, always with, lives for me! And smday he'll raise me fr dead & bring me be w/him frvr!" Mary made res very prsnl!

- Dear Xians, I hope you'd do same. Whnvr you're feeling hrtbrkn, hear J ask, "Why crying?" Hear Bk Pss ask: "Why you dwncst, O my soul? Why so distrbd w/in me?" (42:5, NIV84). It's not like J dsn't know what brks your hrt & brings you dwn. But what does he do? Stands beside his empty tmb & says: "I know what you're going thru. But don't lose hrt. I'm: here, not in there; alive, not dead; with you, not gone! You nvr have feel abndnd, alone, or hrtbrkn ever again! My res means: 'Nthr dth/life, nthr angls/dmns, nthr prsnt/futr, nor any pwrs, nthr hght/dpth, nor anthng else in all crtn'll be able seprt [you] fr love/God that is in [me,] CJ [your] Lord' (Rom 8:38-39)."
- And while that East Gos is true for all Xians all ovr wrld, today I want you make res very persnl. J lookd at her & calld her by name: "Mary." Today J looks at you & calls you by name: "_____." You: not just a nameless face in sea/Xians to J. J calls you by name, & calls on you to make his res very persnl. Whtvr strggls you're facing, battles fightng, probs dealing with, hrtachs weigh you dwn res/J is answr to them all. Res guarantees: they temprry, will pass away, and J'll be w/you until they do. Res guarantees: God loves you persnly & will smday raise you from dth to life. "Why crying? Why dwncst, O my soul? Why so distrbd w/in me?" J is alive! He's here w/you, and he always will be.
- So can you see? Res is very persnl! This East morn, in early hrs/day, while sun still rising, and wrld arnd us is just waking up, take momnt & take in the res for your own hrt. Stand outside tmb; hear J call you by name; and be at peace. J rose for you, persnly. Make J's res very personal.
