Jesus Is Still Pouring Out His Spirit

- "Come, HS, fill the hearts of your faithful ppl & kindle in us the fire of your love." And on 1st Pent, exctly what HS did: filled hrts/mths/minds 1st discs/J & whole bunch brand new Xians; & kindld in them fire Xian faith. That 1st Pent day: awsm day! 50th day aftr Pssvr Sab. 50 days before this, when J died, city/Jrslm packd w/ppl celbrtng Pssvr. That GF night into Sat: Pssvr Sab (day/rest follwng Pssvr). But now 50 days later, city packd w/ppl again, now to celbrt hrvst fest called Wks or Pent. And as ppl fr all over wrld are celbrtng the hrvst, HS has a hrvst/souls. With sound/wind, tngs/fire, langs spkn, & Gos proclmd J poured out Spirit, 1000s ppl came to faith, and Xian Ch was born. Pent: awsm day!
- That's why we celbrt it ev yr just like how in our Xian calndr, ev yr: J's birth, epiph, bap, Supper, dth, res, asc ev yr; wldn't miss! But there's smthng diff re Pent. Pent: not just one-time event. J: only born/ died/rose once. And of course, those events have enormous ongoing signfnc for us & salvtn. But only hap once. Today what I'd like emphsz w/you: Pent/HS hasn't stopped; his work is ongoing. What hapnd in Ac 2: begnnng of a Gos downpour that continues to this very day & will cont until Last Day. *Theme!*

1) Through His Powerful Word

- How? Thru pwrfl wrd. HS wrks thru wrds. I tch all my Cat stdnts: HS wrks thru MofG:Gos/W&S. God shares Gos w/us in Wrd/Bible/Scrptrs. And conncts Wrd to wtr/bap & brd/wine of Com. HS wrks thru wrds. We see that on Pent. All these ppl fr all these ntns are hearing wondrs/God, Gos/Xp in wrds they cld undrstnd. And when hrvst fest done, they'd go back home & sprd wrd re what hrd. Pt got up, prchd pwrfl Pent sermon using wrds; and his msg cld not be stoppd. I love how HS used sound/wind. Know: wrd/spirit, same as wind? And you can't stop: wind; tornd/hurren. Just blows w/pwrful, unstoppbl force. It's like that w/HS. He: holy wind that blows & cannot be stopped. I also love how HS used flames/fire that Ac 2 calls tngs. We spk wrds w/tngs. Gos is sprd when spk it w/tngs. And what fire do? 2 thngs: destrys & refines. Wrd/God destrys sin, pride, unholiness, false doctrn, & evently all unbels. Also refines our hrts; cleanses, purifies, sanctfs us. So w/ sound/wind, tngs/fire, diff langs wrd/Gos sprd arnd wrld like unstppbl wind. Or thnk like this: Joel prphcy: vs. 17b. Pour what say when rainng hard? Pouring outside. And can't stop rain; just pours dwn! When Doppler radar turn green/yellow/red, means we're in dwnpour. That's Pent! HS had always been raining down the Gos: thruout OT, here/there. But at Pent, a Gos hurren made Indfall; a deluge God's grace rained dwn fr hvn w/unstoppable force.
- That still hapnng today? J still pouring out Spirit? I don't hear mirclous wind; I don't think I have fire on head; and I know can't speak in lang nvr studied. Smtms I think: wldn't be awesome if we came ch (kids school) and prs/tchs were so visibly filled w/Spirit that literal tngs/fire came on heads & other miracles accmpnd our prchng/tchng. Ch/school'd be packed, just like Jrslm packed w/newly baptzd bels.
- But we don't see those same mircls today, do we? Does that mean J has stoppd pouring out Spirit? No, J is still... How? Thru pwrfl wrd. Same L&G msg Pt prchd on Pent is what you hear at SJLC Sun/Sun. Same lessons J tght discs: tght in our ch classes & Luth school year-round. Same HS, who: hovrd over wtrs at creatn; wrkd faith in hrts/Hebrws; descndd upon J as dove at bap; verblly insprd writrs/Bible to record exact wrds/God; and was pourd out on Pent that same HS's been poured out in hrt/bels of ev genrtn. Ev person who's ev been a Xian, only became a Xian bec of work/HS. The only reason you are Xian is bec God poured his Spirit into your hrt. And until end/time, HS'll continue fan into flame the fire of Xian faith in hrts of God's ppl arnd wrld. That: HS's ongoing wrk: to blow like wind, to be poured dwn like rain, to ignite fire/faith. So yes, J is still pouring out his Spirit thru his pwrfl wrd...

2) To Fulfill Powerful Promises

• ...to fulfill pwrfl proms. Prom, as you know: only as good as one who makes it. Smone who frequtly lies – you probly not going bel their proms. I promsd my fam: this wk we'd go on fam vaca. I'm not a liar, but I suppose hypthtcly smthng cld come up that'd keep us fr leaving. Prom: always contingent on

ability/desire of prom-maker. God is prom-maker/keeper. He has both ability/desire to accmpsh evthng he proms do. So when God makes prom, you can be absoltly certain that he'll keep that prom.

- Start w/J's prom of Pent. Sevrl times J promsd he'd send HS on Pent. In today's Gos: "The Advct, HS, whom Fr'll send in my name, will tch you all thngs & remind you of evthng I've said to you" (Jn 14:26). Also: "[The Fr'll] give you anthr Advct to help you & be w/you forever Spirit/truth... He lives w/you & will be in you" (16-17). "When Advct comes, whom I'll send to you fr the Fr the Spirit/truth who goes out fr Fr he'll testify re me" (15:26). And right before ascndng: "In few days you'll be baptzd w/HS" (Ac 1:5). J promsd send his Spirit & kept that prom. J nvr brks his proms. If you've ever felt pain of smone brkng prom they made to you, you know how much that hurts. You nvr have to worry re that w/J. He's perfectly dependable & always fulfills his pwrfl proms.
- ✓ God promsd send Sav; Bethlhm; of virgin; suff/die to pay/sins/wrld; rise fr dead; be w/us always; adopt us into fam thru bap; unite himself to us in HC. Tell me: what proms has God ever brokn? Here proms: vs. 17-18. That means reglr/ordnry ppl (like you/me, men/wmn, yng/old) we all are empwrd to share Gos, to "prophecy" maybe not in pub min as pr/tchr, but in persnl lives as ppl/God. So get out there & share your faith! HS'll be speakng thru you that's a prom. Here's another prom: vs. 19-20. Kinda scary, but talking re end/wrld. God proms that he'll nvr stop sprding Gos arnd wrld until he brings this wrld to an end. Does that mean evone'll bel Gos? Certnly not. Even on 1st Pent: vs. 13. And so it is today: J is mockd; Xianity ridiculd; wrld laughs at us for belvng in J/Sav. Kinda makes us want huddle tog in "house where [we] sitting" & keep Gos to selves. But is that what discs did? No! Spirit filled them not only w/faith but also w/boldness to actually get out there & proclaim wonders/God. Shame on us when our timidity gets in way of ministry. Whether it's as indvdls (you/me), as cong (SJ), or as synod (WELS), time is now for us to speak msg Spirit has given us to speak bec vs. 21 incl evone who hears/bels God's pwrfl Gos proms spread thru ppl like us.

Conclusion

• At end/day, vs. 41. Pretty awesome day! Pretty awesome day here at SJ, too. Adult bap; big new member welcome. Spirit is at work. And maybe it's not quite as visibly impressive as was that 1st Pent – with sound/wind, tngs/fire, langs, & huge crwds being baptzd. But J: still pouring out Spirit. Pent was not just a one-time event. HS's wrk: pwrfl & ongoing! He still wrks thru pwrfl Wrd/God to fulfill pwrfl proms/God. This is the victory march of the Gos, which will not cease until God brings this wrld to an end. So to you, O HS, we offer our praise/thanks, and we pray: "Come, HS, fill the hearts of your faithful ppl & kindle in us the fire of your love."

⁹Parthians, Medes and Elamites; residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, ¹⁰Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya near Cyrene; visitors from Rome ¹¹(both Jews and converts to Judaism); Cretans and Arabs—we hear them declaring the wonders of God in our own tongues!" ¹²Amazed and perplexed, they asked one another, "What does this mean?"

¹³Some, however, made fun of them and said, "They have had too much wine."

¹⁴Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice and addressed the crowd:

"Fellow Jews and all of you who live in Jerusalem, let me explain this to you; listen carefully to what I say. ¹⁵These people are not drunk, as you suppose. It's only nine in the morning! ¹⁶No, this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel:

¹⁷"In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy, your young men will see visions, your old men will dream dreams. ¹⁸Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my Spirit in those days, and they will prophesy. ¹⁹I will show wonders in the heavens above and signs on the earth below, blood and fire and billows of smoke. ²⁰The sun will be turned to darkness and the moon to blood before the coming of the great and glorious day of the Lord. ²¹And everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.""

⁴⁰With many other words he warned them; and he pleaded with them, "Save yourselves from this corrupt generation." ⁴¹Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.
