UW-Parkside's Rita Cinema on the Avenue of the Arts at the UW-Parkside campus in Kenosha. Steve Zambo, the producer/director of the film, will also be there to talk about the making of the film.

What's the film about?

The movie follows the inspiring story of WELS pastor David Rosenau. God led him on a unique career path from mortician's assistant, to policeman, to undercover narcotics detective. God used those jobs to prepare him for the ultimate destination God had planned for him: becoming a pastor.

Pastor Rosenau uprooted his young family to spend eight years training for the ministry. Along the way, God placed him in challenging situations, assigning him to take charge of a dying congregation during his vicar year and completely confounding his expectations of how God would use him when he received his call to his first parish.

The film was inspired by a presentation Pastor Rosenau made to the WELS Leadership Conference a couple of years ago. In addition, the synod released a congregational Bible study based on the presentation that you might have participated in.

How much does it cost?

The showing is free and even the concessions are reasonably priced.
