The Council adopted mid-year changes to the Section 107 Parsonage Allowance Exclusion for Mrs. Erin Galgan and Mrs. Ahnsharee Klusmeyer. It was noted they have begun work on the Regenerative Water Conveyance System as part of the SLHS expansion project.
